

Continued Use of VA Form 26-1802a (HUD/VA Addendum to URLA)

1. Purpose. The purpose of this Circular is to inform lenders that the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) will continue to use VA Form 26-1802a, (Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)/VA Addendum to Uniform Residential Loan Application (URLA)).

2. Background. In December 2020, HUD announced that the agency is discontinuing use of the HUD/VA Addendum to URLA, known as HUD-Form 92900-A and VA Form 26-1802a. See HUD Mortgagee Letter 2020-49. Although HUD released a new form to meet HUD's respective program requirements, HUD's action has no effect on VA's use of VA Form 26-1802a.

3. Action. VA will continue to utilize VA Form 26-1802a, (HUD/VA Addendum to URLA) for all loan applications in VA's home loan programs. VA may, at a future date, release an updated version of the form. However, lenders should continue using the current version until VA announces otherwise.

5. Paperwork Reduction Act. The information collection requirements contained in this document have been approved by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) under the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (44 U.S.C. § 3501-3520), and assigned OMB control number 2900-0144. In accordance with the Paperwork Reduction Act, VA may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to a collection of information unless the collection displays a currently valid OMB control number.
