Annual Increase in Construction Cost Index and Specially Adapted Housing (SAH), Special Housing Adaptations (SHA), and Temporary Residence Adaptations (TRA) Grants

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. Effective October 1, 2014, the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) announces that the SAH, SHA, and TRA grant amounts will increase. In order to match the Turner cost of construction increase of 4.307 percent, the maximum grant amounts for Veterans and Servicemembers eligible for housing assistance under Title 38 U.S.C., Section 2101(a), 2101(b), and 2101A, has been increased as follows:
 - a. \$70,465 for individuals eligible under Section 2101(a);
 - b. \$14,093 for individuals eligible under Section 2101(b);
 - c. \$30,934 for individuals eligible under Section 2101A(b)(1); and
 - d. \$5,523 for individuals eligible under Section 2101A(b)(2).
 - 2. <u>Rescission</u>: This Circular is automatically rescinded October 1, 2016.
