## 1.0 Release Notes for LGY Suite - LGY 21.9

### Release Notification

**From:** LGY

**Version:** 21.9

**Production Deployment Date:** June 23, 2021 @ 8:00PM CT/9:00PM ET

**Focus of Release:** The areas of focus for the 21.9 release include enhancements to the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for the Certificate of Eligibility (COE), enrichments to file boarding and data requests, and updates to verbiage on the COE and 589 Letter (Welcome Guaranty Letter to Veterans). The value added through these changes increases the capabilities of the LGY Suite program participant to provide more accurate and prompt service to Veterans.

### 1.1 Enhancements

Key	Component	Summary
LGY-1313539	COE	This enhancement updates the COE FAQ to ensure accurate entitlement information for Veterans is included.
LGY-1314398	Loan Processing	This enhancement revises language on the 589 letter to inform Veterans how entitlement is calculated.
LGY-1315884	WebLGY	This enhancement adds additional verbiage to the COE "Fiduciary Condition" relating to prior approvals for loans that are not an Interest Rate Reduction Refinance Loan (IRRRL) of a non-delinquent VA-Guaranteed loan.

### 1.2 Bugs

LGY-1314635	LGYHub	This fix updates an error message to appear when an invalid LIN is searched in the Appraiser Assignment field. The following error message now appears: "Error: Invalid case number or user is not authorized to access the case record."

LGY-1314656	WebLGY	This fix now displays the Document Review on the correspondence page in WebLGY to internal users only and is no longer accessible to external users.
LGY-2720	WebLGY	This fix ensure the Letters for Final Notification and Veteran Litigation are now addressed correctly. Previously, the addresses for the Veteran and Builder were in the wrong portion of the letter.
LGY-1315399	WebLGY	This fix updates an error message on the WebLGY Correspondence Page. If an invalid sales contract is uploaded with an incorrect file size, then the following message will appear: "Valid Sales Contract is Required. File Size must be greater than 0KB and less than 100.0MB."
